Lounge chairs not available until summer season. Please close the bathroom doors after use to prevent vandalism.

Weather permitting, we'll be turning the heater on just before the beginning of spring break, before March 25th, to take the winter chill off. After that, the solar panels will maintain the temperature if the weather stays warm.

MAJOR POOL WORK

Pool closed 2-3 weeks in May

It's time to re-fiberglass both pools and bring our pool up to code (main drain in big pool split, replacement of drain covers, LED lights, black line added to steps, etc). Approx. cost \$45,000. Other major improvements needed will be heater replacement, pumps, filters, electrical work. We already replaced 40' of rusted pool fence (\$2900). THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL ASSESSMENT TO **DO THIS WORK!!** Our reserve acct has been well managed and your past dues will pay for this. Note: If work cannot be started by May 1st these major overhauls might need to be postponed to the Fall.



Parking on Streets

OVERSIZED VEHICLES (RV, etc.) cannot be parked on the street between 2 AM and 6 AM

Specifically, <u>section 86.0139</u> of the San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) prohibits oversized, non-motorized and recreational vehicles from parking on public streets between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. **Permit needed for 1 day exception.**
