SPRING BREAK AT THE POOL

(NO MONITORS ON DUTY)

Monitors do not come on duty until Memorial Day weekend: 5/27. Plan to visit the pool with children under the age of 15 as they **MUST** have an adult with them (**State health code**).

Lounge chairs not available until summer season. Please close the bathroom doors after use to prevent vandalism.

<u>Weather permitting</u>, we'll be turning the heater on just before the beginning of spring break (March 27th) to take the winter chill off. After that, the solar panels will maintain the temperature if the weather stays warm.

NEW BOARD MEMBERS OR HIRE PROPERTY MANAGERS?

We need more help as we lost 2 very involved Board Members (BMs) last year due to health issues and the other BMs & volunteers are being overworked. When we asked for Board Members in last year's July bill/proxy/ballot and September newsletter, we received no response. Specifically we need a reliable person who will be the "Pool Party/Monitor Liaison" (collect the \$20 deposit and see it's returned in a timely manner if pool & park are cleaned up). This is usually a summer job with an average of 10 parties. Then report monthly to the Board and answer emails throughout the year. The other open position is "Pool Maintenance" - oversee any maintenance needed at the pool and eventually work closely with the pool company. Or just come on Board to be a "BM at Large" and start getting involved. Call either # and leave a message of your interests: 858-566-3622 or 858-413-5426 and someone will return your call. We meet once a month on the 2nd Tuesday evening. Otherwise, without help, we will have to look for property managers and that will deplete our reserves and increase our annual dues considerably. 2 AM and 6 AM

Specifically, section 86.0139 of the San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) prohibits oversized, non-motorized and recreational vehicles from parking on public streets between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. Permit needed for 1 day exception.
