Your annual BILL of \$216 will be sent out by the end of June



POOL OPEN 10 AM - 9 PM

- Monitors on duty beginning Memorial Weekend.
- Do not visit pool if feeling ill (Have a fever, coughing, etc).
- NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED IN GATED AREA
- Pool will remain open during regular hours if we get no complaints, we have small groups*, and everything remains clean and orderly when monitors are not on duty. Otherwise the pool & bathroom will have to be deadbolted.
- Monitors have control of the pool at all times. Persons abusing the rules will be asked to leave the pool area.
- Monitors have the authority to confiscate pool keys.
